Overall the job is not hard to learn I work in the PUPPI division where we make fiberglass cross arms for electric poles. An overview of what happens is, the beams get made in pultrusion then they go to a driller which inspects and drills holes which goes to pinners. They shove bushings down where the holes are then put pins in. Flip the beams a few times to get all of the sides then it goes to foaming, you put 7 at a time on a rack and shoot expanding foam into it, cap it, and clamp it and wait 8 minutes to de-pin and do it all over again. Next they get cleaned by hand to get assembled by an assembler with unique mounts depending on the buyer. I have also in like my other jobs have branched out and trained in other areas. I am a certified driller, which has to configure the drill, measures beams, and keeps check on initial quality of beams. I am also currently a line lead, their responsibility is the line and everyone in it, we also make sure the line never stops and to make sure quality is up to par. They also observe the line and help wherever in the line that needs help. There are plenty of small things that I have learned that not too many of the normal line workers either don't know or are not trusted to operate but are trivial to list. I am looking for another job because recently I had an opportunity to move back to Rochester and did with the proposition of helping my girlfriend and soon to be fiancée go to school. She is becoming a medical esthetician and she has to quit work to do it, being completely dependent on me. I know my job history if I quit this job doesn't look the best I look like a job hopper but I need to do something if I am going to make this work and I hope you give me a chance to see that I am a hard worker and even better learner.
