Key Accomplishments

Optimized warehouse layout to increase space utilization by 48%. Avoided cost to create additional 2,025 sq ft, representing an estimated cost avoidance of \$385K.

Decreased DIOH for components inside the CEA from 15 days to 2 days. Achieved a 63% (120 sq ft) space reduction. Project improved the environmental conditions on CEA.

Decreased FG/WIP DOH by 40% to support inventory turns goal.

Led a Shop Floor Control Kaizen event to review material handlers role and focus on value added tasks. Project impact \$20K.

Drove \$288K cost-out through intra-island routes consolidation and reduction of indirect reports by 36%. Had to negotiate with local suppliers to transfer them the local transportation cost and delivery responsibility.

Identified, processed and collected \$250K from freight payment center mis-charges, carrier overcharges and back charges to suppliers for the use of non-GE contract carriers.

Drove 24.9% and \$115K in productivity for the GE logistics warehouse operation as a result of indirect labor reduction and cost reductions on cleaning and waste disposal services.

Drove \$100K cost reduction on intra-island special trips by consolidating all shipments with one carrier. Designed and implemented a special trips report and measuring system.

Optimized GE warehouse layout and increased space utilization to include other inventory consolidation projects without leasing additional warehouse space. Yearly cost benefit \$63K.

Implemented process to track container movement and decreased demurrage costs by 73% representing \$48K cost-out.
