## Work History

Hyvee Distribution Warehouse: Job duties includes picking at a very fast pace and maintaining production at 100% or over. I would scan a pick ticket at the beginning of my shift and then log into the system using an automated voice talkman which tells me the location, aisle, minutes I have to pick, etc. (2/14- 4/14) approx

VT Industries: Operated the Heian 3 automated CNC machine while checking for quality and doing random audits on doors. Micrometers, calipers, and other hand tools are used for measuring. My main priority is watching the machine for errors, troubleshooting when needed, and making sure the measurement's is within tolerance. Have also operated the D.E.T and have completed training as the Hardware Coordinator. (2/13- 2/14)

Doherty Staffing/Masterson: Assigned to work at Jonti-Craft located in Wabasso, MN. Duties such as assembling woodcraft items and forming it into cabinet, drawer, etc and also boxing and inspecting finished items going down the conveyor line before getting scanned into the system. Operation of CNC automated robotics programmed to perform tasks to produce wood furniture and tables. Have operated the E210,W210,310 and MAW German machines manually using programs and CAD drawings to help identify the item. (7/11-11/12- 2nd shift) Laid off for a few months in between. Quit because I moved to Iowa since I'm having a baby soon.

Ocean State Joblot Distributing Warehouse: Located in N. Kingston, R.I. Duties such

as Picker/Splitter/Shipper. As a splitter we pick up non-conveyable items from the receiving dock and scan it using RF scanners before splitting it to different pallets which has different store locations. When helping out at shipping I load the trucks and then tape bill of lading on the side. When picking I'll scan a pick label which shows me a zone and location to pick from then pick until the order is complete. All 3rd shift employees are required to have their electric driving pallet jacks for short and long forks since we use these equipment's for almost the entire shift. Had forklift training but didn't complete it because I've moved to M.N. (3/11-7/11- 3rd shift)

U.S. Temps: Assigned to work at Ocean State Joblot before getting hired there. Duties such as unloading and regular warehouse cleaning. Unloading containers while checking for SKU and P.O. numbers making sure that they are on the paperworks before sorting them out and placing it on separate pallets. At times will scan finished production and run it out to its warehouse location then scanning it to inventory. ( 9/10-3/11- 3rd shift) Got hired on.
