loading empty pallets into trucks sorting out the trash and building stacks of good pallets for loaders to use as dunnage as well as cardboard and tires for loading the freight and making sure that it's not damaged and secured scanners just started to be how unloading and loading the trucks instead of having to handwritten every single piece of freight on the trailers making labels for all the freight that wasn't on the paperwork and making sure that we were supposed to receive that freight sorting out all the trash trailers and locating freight that was needed for delivery the next day inventory on all of the trailers that weren't gonna be moving every trailer was handwritten and marked on a diagram of the trailer as well as marking all hazmat and making sure the driver was able to move hazmat unloading all the hazmat and reloading the trailer if they didn't have the proper permit for every trailer they had going out

Locating all of the missing freight and then handwriting all the trailer's that didn't have paperwork checking forklifts and making sure that they were able to be used for the next crew that was coming in and helping them unload their trailers and putting the freight in the right location that it called for and locating the missing freight that needed to be loaded out for the next day loading the route for the driver and making sure the truck was loaded up how he was going to be delivering that day labels for freight that was missing the label or never got one marking the freight as it came in with the right location that it called for moving the freight to the right location and then helping load the freight that wasn't going to make it and loading it onto another trailer and writing it down on the paperwork wrapping pallets that were damaged on incoming loads and outgoing freight moving the pups and hooking up sets that were going out that day making sure they are attached and secure and making sure that they are the correct trailers that are supposed to go together as well as helping drivers move their trailers that they weren't able to get out straightening the yard so that the empty trailers have enough room to get as many as possible in that row
