As a motor hand I would make my rounds, around the location to make sure the rig is properly running which consists of maintenance on all my motors, checking oil, changing filters, clean radiator fans, checking coolant levels, taking rig fuel readings right to make sure all my motors were up and running the correct way. Also make sure that there are no open valves, service the top drives.

Loader operations such as unloading casing, hot shot trucks, and chemicals . I handled Derek hand inspections, safety inspections on slings and lines making sure everything's up to date as well as chains and equipment being ready to be used.

Climb the Derek to latch pipe to make connections, run the ST80 on the floor. Dump bar down the hopper, assemble and breakdown the rig to move location sites. Teach Floorhand to make connections and assist in getting the job done safe.

As a Floor hand I would help the driller by making connections and throwing slips, and also put casing down hole . Some of my other duties were checking the mud pumps to assure proper water flow, making sure connections on the hoses were rigged up correctly to allow the most amount of safety possible. Helping with the set up and break down of the rig along with moving it to different locations. Other tasks include assembling the BOP together, driving equipment such as a front end loader, backhoe, skid steer, fuel truck, mini excavator and a haul truck. Running a cat walk to haul pipe up to make pipe connections, as well as do what's necessary to keep the floors clean for safety for all the employees.

### **Driller**

June 2016 to May 2018

I was a rescue miner that helped everyone stay safe and if they weren't safe my job was to get them out in a safe manner.

My job title was a driller with the fast 65. I would drill into the holes into the marble so that the wire saw operators could run their diamond wire assuring they could make there cuts where they are needed. I would run the skid steer underground, set up tracks for the wire saw, set cribbage, pound rebar and make drill holes for roof support.

### **Construction worker**

My job was to use the appropriate tools to locate gas lines, phone lines, power lines sewer and water. I would make sure that everything was ready to go for the directional driller such as make sure we never ran out of water and chemicals that we would need to make the mud soft that allows him to make the cut he needed. I would also run the mini excavator to dig a bore hole for a good visual to see the drill bit come out the other side so we could run the conduit back through the bore hole that we drill so the fiber guys could come and run there internet cable.

## **Underground Coal Miner**

West Elk Mine-Paeonia Colorado

September 2014 to April 2015

I was a rescue miner making sure both the mine and people are safe. If there was a problem in the mine it was my job to get people out safe and continue to do what's necessary to stabilize the mine area.

I made sure everything was ready and loaded on to the bolter, I set cans, set timbers for roof support as well as rib screening for blow out protection. I would hang ventilation tubes throughout the mine to make consistent good quality air flow. I built concrete pads for the long wall and would run the buggy's to haul coal to the shoots. I worked both outby and inby on the mine hauling rock dust to different parts of the mine to make sure it didn't catch fire. I would work the long wall cleaning out Pilar's and making sure nothing got jammed that would clog up the process.
