AT GRACO WE DO A VERY WIDE VARIETY OF ASSEMBLY, TESTING, INSPECTING AND PACKING. WHEN I FIRST STARTED AT GRACO I WAS PUT IN THE SMALL PARTS DEPARTMENT WHERE I'D BUILD, TEST, AND PACK A VARIETY OF PARTS FROM INJECTORS TO VALVES. I WOULD MAKE ALL DIFFERENT KINDS OF PARTS AND SUB ASSEMBLIES THAT GO TO CUSTOMERS OF GRACO ACCORDING TO THE BLUE PRINTS, PART LISTS AND PACKAGING GUIDES. I WAS MOVED AROUND THROUGHOUT ARE DEPARTMENT BECAUSE I AM A QUICK LEARNER AND WAS ABLE TO DO WHATEVER GRACO ASKED OF ME. THE DIFFERENT LINES I WAS ON AFTER BEING MOVED FROM SMALL PARTS BASED ON WHAT THE COMPANY NEEDED AT THE TIME. THEY WERE PUMP ELEMENTS, WHERE I WOULD BUILD THE PUMP ELEMENT AND RUN IT THROUGH A COMPUTER OPERATED TEST BENCH AND THEN SEND THE SUB ASSEMBLY TO DIFFERENT DEPARTMENTS TO BE USED. THEN I WAS MOVED TO ROBOT ASSEMBLY WHERE I LEARNED HOW TO OPERATE AND RUN FOUR DIFFERENT ROBOTS THROUGHOUT THE DAY THAT WERE MAKING DIFFERENT PARTS THAT WOULD EITHER BE A SUB ASSEMBLY THAT WAS SENT OFF TO BE USED OR PACKAGED AND ALSO MAKING DIFFERENT MANIFOLD INJECTORS THAT WERE A FINISHED PRODUCT THAT I WOULD PACKAGE AND SEND OUT. AFTER LEARNING ROBOTS I WAS MOVED TO THE SHRINKWRAP LINE WHERE I LEARNED HOW TO USE TWO DIFFERENT MACHINES TO SHRINK WRAP PARTS THAT I WAS TO INSPECT WHILE PACKING AND THEN SEND OUT THE FINISHED PACKED PRODUCT TO CUSTOMERS AND THE LAST LINE I HAVE BEEN MOVED TO IS BASE PLATES, WHERE I HAVE TO MAKE DIFFERENT PARTS ACCORDING TO A LIST OF PARTS AND THE BLUE PRINT AND I HAVE TO CAREFULLY INSPECT EACH OF THE PARTS GOING INTO MAKING THE BASE PLATE AND AFTER I BUILD THEM I'D THEN TEST THEM ON A MANUAL TEST BENCH ONE AT A TIME INSURING THAT EACH ONE TESTS TO ITS PERFORMANCE REQUIREMENT BEFORE BEING SENT OUT.
