I am responsible for keeping LACT units running and trouble-shooting problems associated to the LACT. Working independently at most times, I communicate problems or complications to the designated department to resolve the problem (measurement, automation, customer, vac truck dispatch) when it's something I am not assigned to fix. Just like all jobs, communication is the key to a successful business. I'm in constant communication with co-workers and supervisors in everyday field operations to do my part in keeping the field running. I routinely inspect LACT units and the pipeline to ensure there are no defects or leaks. Does daily maintenance checks on forklift and overhead crane. Rigs up Frac Stacks on locations when asked to do so. Makes sure inventory is stocked at all times and orders equipment when necessary.
