


YOUR SOCIAL SECURITY CARD

Detach the card below and sign it in ink immediately. Keep your card in a safe place to prevent loss or theft. Do not laminate your card.



Place your number in a safe place to prevent their misuse. Application and submit evidence to prove your number is yours. Do not give out evidence of U.S. citizenship at exactly what you need to do. Do not let your employer get your

number for reporting purposes. Such use is not allowed. Do not use your security number by such an organization. Private organizations do not know your number. Do not let your number must tell you: whether you are a U.S. citizen, and how the number will be used.

Your Social Security card will be marked "INVALID" if you use the card for purposes other than those listed on the card.

Do not show your Social Security card to anyone other than the officials who require it. If you show this card to someone other than the officials who require it, you may be fined or imprisoned.
