During my over 10 years of employment at Vestas I held multiple positions with increasing levels of leadership and responsibilities. The following is a summary of those roles.

Repair Technician:

Responsible for performing structural and cosmetic repairs to wind turbine blades. The wind turbine blades are constructed of fiberglass, resins and epoxies. The construction requires skill in handling delicate materials and performing sensitive repairs. Precision mending and the restoration of fiberglass & gel coats. As a repair technician I was also responsible for maintaining a clean and organized workstation.

Manufacturing Supervisor:

As a key member of the manufacturing team; I was responsible for leading and directing process leads in the safe execution of the daily production plan. Accountable for my team's performance in safety, quality, delivery and production schedules.

Process Team Lead:

As a team lead, I was responsible for directing and leading my crew in the safe execution of the daily production plan. The team lead is an integral member of the process team with ~70% time dedicated to leadership/administration with ~30% time on production. This position required me to emphasize a positive environment which fosters team member safety, collaboration and accountability.

Trainer:

Utilized Standard Operating Procedures to train and evaluate new hires. Applied and leveraged train the trainer methodologies for all company policies and procedures. In this role I was required to have a strong understanding of PPE usage, safety procedures and an overall understanding of the operation including time reporting and associated HR systems.

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Quality Technician:

This position required detailed leadership focused on quality. As a quality technician I was responsible for all aspects of quality supporting blade production. Through this role I became a certified trainer, auditor and approver.
