I would also check pump stations and reservoirs radio frequency's to make sure they working properly. I jetted ¼ of highlands ranch sewer problem areas and low flow areas. Installed 2 miles of 12" recycle sewer line to wastewater plant and contributed in Roberts filter recycle plant installation and installing fiber optics control center. Manhole inspections every year making sure flows were good and there were no blockages. I would get ph test at fire hydrants at different locations through out highlands ranch, also got samples from south platte river and sewer samples from different locations at the sewer plant facility.
