Pressure washing glass with warm water after sandblasting was done as well. Also cutting glass sheets to exact length using a tape measure and cutting tool, other power tools such as sanders and grinders were use to trim and smooth out sharp edges.

Cutting aluminum material. Use of saw square, and tape measure. Cuts were made square or angled. Reading a blueprint was necessary to make angled cuts or to pipes for rialling steps using a saw.

Outdoor unloading raw material with forklift from semis required attention to detail and surroundings due to small space and large heavy loads, receiving pallets and hardware also manually unload frames from trucks.

Drilling

Use of blueprint, square and tape measure to set drill press. Make measurements, mark then dill and stack to correct pallet. Count and label pallet, shrink wrap and continue to next procedure.

Cleaning, grinding, deburing, d.a, and sanding aluminum rails using air tools. Attention to detail.

Assembly

Usage of tape measure, hand drill, router, skill saw, table saw, hammer drill, jig saw, wrenches, sockets, band saw and many other power tools were necessary. Heavy lifting and bending over also required to lay decking using drill, screws and routers to make perfect holes. Once finished, stack decks onto a large pallet, by hand. Steel band it, shrink wrap, label with job and quantity.

Some mig welding occasionally. Read blueprint, setup station, gather correct parts to built from drawing. Make tacks then welds.

Shrink wrap pallet and take to designated area. I also worked in a fish market (Morey's), this position was base on pulling orders for other local companies. These job involved picking oysters, cleaning and weighting, pack box filled with ice, wight the box, print information label and stack on pallets. I also helped with shipping and loading delivery trucks. Another position I had was Sandblasting metal and plastic parts with metal pellets and sand, these was a seasonal position for a metal shop company.

These job required on following procedures. Use of press to assemble diesel particulate filters and ceramic liquid filters. Adjusting press with wrenches when needed and repair pressure hoses with tools. Use of hand power tools such as drills, screwdrivers, digital calipers, tape measure, sanders, sand paper, spatulas and wrenches was part of the job. Manually load and unload 50 lbs filters into furnace for baking up to 2500 degrees. Repair cracked filters with cement, using heat gun and spatula (attention to detail) then sand evenly with sander or sand paper, and after measure using a caliper for proper size. Finally, load filters into pallet for shipping, wight and shrinkwrap then print label with all correct paperwork for shipping. Unloading trucks was done using forklift and palletjacks using a scanner to enter to computer system, then stock and restock materials necessary to keep production flowing.

Generally, I would grab a metal part and carefully sharp, grind or burr it down from the edges, on a rotating sandpaper machine. Depending on the part, I would use a different machine for every different part. Once finish, I had to stock or hang the parts on boxes or hooks, the boxes where stack on its individual shelf on the next department. I also did some polishing and buffing, in these area it consisted on shining or polish the metal part till chromed with a special wax on rotating fabric wheel, these polishing orders had to be checked and sign by the supervisor before going to the next department.
