- **NATIONAL DEFENSE SERVICE MEDAL**—The National Defense Service Medal (NDSM) is a decoration awarded to members of the United States Marine Corps (USMC) who have served honorably during periods of designated national emergency or conflict. Established in 1953, the NDSM recognizes the dedication and commitment of Marines who have contributed to the defense of the nation. Eligible criteria include active duty service during specified time periods, such as the Korean War, Vietnam War, Persian Gulf War, and other periods of conflict. Recipients of the NDSM proudly display this medal as a symbol of their service and sacrifice in support of the nation's defense.
- **SEA SERVICE DEPLOYMENT RIBBON**—The Sea Service Deployment Ribbon (SSDR) is a decoration awarded to members of the United States Marine Corps (USMC) who have completed a standard deployment at sea aboard a U.S. Navy vessel. Established in 1980, the SSDR recognizes Marines who have participated in significant maritime operations and contributed to the readiness and effectiveness aboard a qualifying vessel, although typically require a minimum of 90 consecutive days of deployment. Recipients of the SSDR proudly wear this ribbon as a testament to their service and dedication to protecting maritime interests and promoting security around the world.
