


Minnesota Work Opportunity Tax Credit (WOTC)


Stapled to this memo is your Minnesota WOTC (Work Opportunity Tax Credit) card. I encourage you to bring it with you to all your job interviews. I would also encourage you to keep it in a safe place. It's not recommended to keep in your wallet, because it can get worn and tattered pretty quickly. You should make a copy or two, of both sides, so if you lose your original card, you can call the number on the back of the card to request a new one.

Provide a copy of this card (both sides) to any potential employer after the interview. Let them know that they would be eligible for a \$2400 tax credit if you remain employed with them for a period of 6 months. Reminder: You will need to show them the original card, but **do not** give the original card to the employer.

These cards are only eligible for new employees. You cannot use it if:

- 1). You have worked for a company before.
- 2). You are going to be working for a family member.
- 3). You own your company.

The WOTC program provides a federal income tax credit to employers in an amount up to \$2,400 for each eligible new hire. **To be certified to claim the credit, the employer must fax or mail a completed IRS Form 8850 to the address below within 28 calendar days of the new hire's start date.**
