I worked in fermenting where I was responsible for receiving wort from the brewhouse, adding yeast to it, filling fermenting tanks, and setting those tanks to a specific temperature for fermentation. Also, I monitored the balling of each fermenter as well as the hours fermenting and would then send the beer to aging when it was within the specifications. Once the beer was gone I would get in each fermenter while following all confined space entry requirements and push the remaining yeast out with a paddle, either to reuse or to go to waste. After that I would cip the tanks and get them ready for more wort.

Injection Mold Operator

At Niagara I was responsible for running the injection molding machines used to make the bottles and caps for the production line. My job duties included keeping the machines running at all times and restarting them whenever they stopped, performing hourly quality checks, weekly cips on all machines, and ensuring the production line was being supplied with bottles and caps at all times. If the line was not running, the bottles and caps would be diverted into gaylords for storage. If the machines were down for any reason I would supply the line with bottles and caps using a forklift to move the storage bins into a hopper for production.
