August 2021 to May 2022

I worked in the PUPPI division where we made fiberglass cross arms for electric poles. An overview of what happens is,

An order is purchased

The beams get made in pultrusion (6 months early)

A forklift driver then retrieves it from storage or on a rare occasion from pultrusion them selves

A driller which is responsible for inspecting the beams and to make sure the right program is loaded. then he will measure and insert the beams into the drill.

After the driller makes a set of 7 (usually) on a cart it goes to the pinners where they insert a hollow fiberglass bushing into the holes drilled and insert a metal pin to keep them in place.

Once in place and all the holes have the right pins in them, they go onto the foaming rack of which we insert expanding foam then clamp it shut for 8 minutes

After 8 minutes they are taken down and de-pinned and given to the cleaners.

Next after the cleaners it goes to the assemblers, there job is to add anything if needed, that includes custom hardware or offset hardware or a prebuild section.

Assemblers are the second most important people on the line. Not only do they assemble but they are responsible for any quality issues not found until they get it. Re-painting, Bondo, recapping, hardware, literally anything wrong with the beams before setting them down on a pallet they are responsible for spotting it.

Last step is to sign a sticker and call a forklift.

Before I had left, I was a line lead. I have been trained on every step of this process; I even went out of my way to learn about other aspects of the job to keep my production smoother.
