At Atlas Roofing I was a machine operator that produced a foam insulated board that is made by a mixture of different chemicals and blowing agents. I started here as a Temp to hire employee and got hired on to the production team. First I worked in the Pre-Fabrication side of the plant where I worked on custom orders for customers by reading work orders given by the Production Supervisor. Working with table saws to cut down foam boards to a specific size for customers orders, also operate a crane to move wood planks onto conveyor table. I would also drive a Forklift to bring materials located throughout the warehouse and bring them over to the designated work area to fulfill orders by other employees. When finish products are done I would then pick them up with a Forklift drive items to the production line to get items wrapped, bagged, labeled, and stored in the correct area throughout the warehouse. Being successful here in the fabrication area lead me to learning the operations of the Shipping department where I learned to stage products for shipments going out that day. Also learned how to load and off load 48ft and 52ft flatbed trucks. Proving myself I worked my way up to a Machine Operator one of the highest positions were I worked on a team of 4 guys. Duties changed as we rotated weekly we would be responsible of moving 1,500 pound facer rolls by a forklift using a carpet pole extension then we would place them on carts and roll them manually into position. Also clean multiports that were previously used on prior runs with cleaning agents such as dinoflush and antifreeze. The main Operator for that week is responsible for reading the daily schedule and entering the correct information into the HMI computer and making sure the correct blowing agents are entered.
