

**Hospital Worker - Cleaning, Disinfection, and Sterilization of Medical Equipment
(April 2002 – April 2005)**

- Clean and dry surgical instruments, intra-uterine devices, vascular catheters, implants and all items to be high-level disinfected.
- Dispose of single use items like gloves, needles, syringes, and tongue depressors
- Open all hinged instruments and other items and disassemble those with sliding or multiple parts
- Remove the items from the container using, dry, high-level disinfected pickups
- Rinse thoroughly with boiled water to remove the chemical residue that is left on items
- Send damaged instruments for repair after appropriate decontamination or discard them if necessary.
