Job Description: Order Selector (15.00 +bonuses)

Responsibilities and duties: Select orders and palletize into stop order, operate a double pallet jack when building orders that range from 50 to 70 cubes (6 feet high). I am a veteran selector which means I am certified on all equipment, highly knowledgeable in quarterly pure safety rules and regulations. I have been crossed trained to select orders in all departments which are (freezer, cooler and dry). Other responsibilities consist of loading trucks, operating standup forklifts, and maintaining cycle counting within each departments own inventory. I report all damaged product to inventory control at the end of every shift, as well as train new employees how to document damaged product for either credits by it being damaged in the manufactory process or within our own facility .I am also responsible for when all new hire employees are brought on to show them how to palletize in stop order efficiently with little to no damage to the company/customer product, while maintaining a safe and stable load for the truck driver. While inspiring others not only to have a positive mindset, but the mindset of a champion. I am ranked in the top eight percent in my company nationwide because of my case count per hour, which are cases picked per hour I currently select at 200-240 cases an hour and my accuracy which is one error per every 4,500 cases sent. Shift hours may vary between 10-14 hours a night. Deadlines have to be met, overtime is mandatory.
