I Detected suspicious activities and watched for criminal acts and rule infractions. I Wrote reports on property damage, theft, presence of unauthorized persons and unusual occurrences. I Secured all doors in the office and main building after hours. I Inspected equipment, structures and materials to identify the cause of errors and defects. I Screened all passengers, crew members and employees for weapons and contraband. I Maintained the custody and control of inmates housed in maximum security unit. I Completed intake paperwork, fingerprints and searches. I Made rounds at specified intervals and conducted head counts and roll calls. I Determined and assigned inmates to appropriate housing. I Arranged for medical and dental care of inmates. I Responded to inquiries from the public, other staff, inmates and visitors. I Created and maintained arrest files on all inmates processed through the jail. I Made sure holding areas were cleaned and that prisoners were served meals on time.

I Supervised youth's daily activities, including school, meals and recreation time. I Observed behavior of residents individually and in groups. I Built solid relationships with staff and residents to help keep the institution safe and secure.
