At Ashley's furniture I was operating a called VT Machine ,that machinery is from Germany and it is used to slice items such as foam,wood,plastic and even some metal at the moment I was using it to cut foam .although there are a couple of steps required before slicing the foam at first I would load a 1000 pound of block foam with a clam forklift.set it up on the conveyor belt slice it in to pieces as needed.and then the slices of foam that were already cut Would required another cut ,this time that sliced foam required a shaped form . After procedure was done I would operate the VT machine to send the finished cut to the offload department.while operating this machine a lot of maintenance was also required from beginning of shift all the way to my shift was over .some of the daily maintenance was to make sure that the blade was sharp enough to begin my shift.in between of the shift if the blade would ither brake or for some reason damage , then I would proceed with the replacement of blade .after shift was over I would also have to make sure that the blade was in good shape to operate for next shift to use and clean the foam that was left inside from my shift.
