I started on the assembly line using hand/power tools putting basic pieces(ie; trim, doors, faceplate) on the units and tightening the nuts & bolts.I was moved to Paint and Pre-assembly. My job was to wash the metal parts for the units, hang them on a rack, place into the oven to dry. When dry, paint them and place back into the oven.. When taken out do a pre –assembly quality check for mistakes like air bubbles, hardware showing, texture, color.If pieces are correct then preassemble. Then I would take the preassembled unit by forklift or hand jack to the assembly line. Unit was re-checked to make sure it matched the blueprints/job order. If a unit was not assembled correctly I would then have to disassemble it and start over.

The position of tower tech consisted of a variety of jobs from climbing a tower for equipment attachment, listing of materials learning safety requirements as well as getting certified in tower climbing and rescue.
