## ANTI-HARASSMENT POLICY

It is Corporate Management Group's (CMG) policy that all employees should be able to enjoy a work environment free from all forms of discrimination, including harassment. As such, CMG is committed to vigorously enforcing their Anti-harassment Policy. This policy applies to all employees of the organization (without regard to position) and individuals not directly connected to CMG (e.g., an outside vendor, consultant, customer or guest). Title VII of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 prohibits employment discrimination based on race, color, creed, religion, national origin, sex, marital status, status with regard to public assistance, membership or activity in a local commission, disability, sexual orientation or veteran status. Harassment is considered a form of discrimination and is specifically included among the prohibitions under Title VII of the Civil Rights Act of 1964. The Anti-harassment Policy prohibits harassment and/or retaliation by any individual employed by, doing business with or for, or visiting CMG. Employees who believe they have been the subject of harassment and/or retaliation or an employee who may have been witness to harassment and/or retaliation must report the incident immediately. Information and/or allegations must be reported to a manager of CMG (by telephoning 866.920.1425 or 303.920.1425). Only those who have an immediate need to know, including the alleged target of harassment or retaliation, the alleged harassers or retaliators, and any witnesses may find out the identity of the complainant. All individuals contacted in the course of an investigation will be advised that all persons involved in a charge are entitled to respect and that any retaliation or reprisal against an individual who is an alleged target of harassment or retaliation, who has made a complaint, or who has provided information in connection with a complaint, is a separate violation of CMG's policy. All information will be disclosed only on a need-to-know basis to allow CMG to

investigate and resolve the incident. CMG recognizes the serious nature of harassment and therefore will endeavor to protect the employee who may have been subjected to harassment, any witnesses and the party against whom allegations have been filed to every possible extent.

Harassment is unlawful and has a negative impact on employees. Violation of the Anti-harassment Policy will not be tolerated by CMG and may result in discipline up to and including termination. Offensive acts or conduct have no legitimate business purpose; accordingly, any employee, regardless of his/her position within CMG, who it is determined has engaged in such conduct will be made to bear the full responsibility for such unlawful conduct.

With respect to sexual harassment, the following is prohibited:

1. Unwelcome sexual advances, request for sexual favors, and all other verbal or physical conduct of a sexual or otherwise offensive nature, especially where:
  - Submission to such conduct is made either explicitly or implicitly a term or condition of employment;

# Form W-4 (2015)

**Purpose.** Complete Form W-4 so that your employer can withhold the correct federal income tax from your pay. Consider completing a new Form W-4 each year and when your personal or financial situation changes.

**Exemption from withholding.** If you are exempt, complete only lines 1, 2, 3, 4, and 7 and sign the form to validate it. Your exemption for 2015 expires February 16, 2016. See Pub. 505, Tax Withholding and Estimated Tax.

**Note.** If another person can claim you as a dependent on his or her tax return, you cannot claim exemption from withholding if your income exceeds \$1,050 and includes more than \$350 of unearned income (for example, interest and dividends).

**Exceptions.** An employee may be able to claim exemption from withholding even if the employee is a dependent, if the employee:

- Is age 65 or older,
- Is blind, or
- Will claim adjustments to income; tax credits; or itemized deductions, on his or her tax return.

The exceptions do not apply to supplemental wages greater than \$1,000.00.

**Basic instructions.** If you are not exempt, complete the **Personal Allowances Worksheet** below. The worksheets on page 2 further adjust your withholding allowances based on itemized deductions, certain credits, adjustments to income, or two-earners/multiple jobs situations.

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

