

Thank you for your interest in enrolling in **MyChart**. Please follow the instructions below to securely access your online medical record. MyChart allows you to send messages to your doctor, view your test results, renew your prescriptions, schedule appointments, and more.

How Do I Sign Up?

1. In your Internet browser, go to www.hcmc.org and click the MyChart button or go to www.MyChart.hcmed.org.
2. Click on the **Sign Up Now** link in the Sign In box. You will see the New Member Sign Up page.
3. Enter your MyChart Access Code exactly as it appears below. You will not need to use this code after you've completed the sign-up process. If you do not sign up before the expiration date, you must request a new code.

4. Enter the last 4 digits of your Social Security Number (xxxx) and Date of Birth (mm/dd/yyyy) as indicated and click **Submit**. You will be taken to the next sign-up page.
5. Create a MyChart ID. This will be your MyChart login ID and cannot be changed, so think of one that is secure and easy to remember.
6. Create a MyChart password. You can change your password at any time. Please note that your MyChart password cannot contain any of the characters or words in your MyChart ID.
7. Enter your Password Reset Question and Answer. This can be used at a later time if you forget your password.
8. Enter your e-mail address. You will receive e-mail notification when new information is available in MyChart.
9. Click **Sign Up**. You can now view your medical record.
