SUBJECTIVE:

Ruth returns for followup of right lower leg contusions. She is 2 weeks out from her contusions and feeling slow, steady improvement. She is doing modified duty, light duty. She is seen with the help of AT&T interpreter. In her work she is sitting 90% of her work time.

REVIEW OF SYSTEMS:

Unchanged since I saw her September 24, 2014.

OBJECTIVE:

Vital signs reviewed in the medical record were normal and Ruth appears comfortable at rest. Ambulatory wearing her CAM walker. She has variable tenderness in the right calf, not well localized. No palpable cord. Slight tenderness medial calf without palpable cord. No swelling. There is variable tenderness somewhat migratory in the right ankle, primarily the lateral malleolar region. Passive range of motion of the right ankle elicits atypical pain. Distal sensation and circulation intact.

ASSESSMENT AND PLAN:

Right leg contusion/right ankle contusion, convalescent. Somewhat delayed resolution. Symptoms out of proportion to physical findings. Continue CAM walker and I will liberalize her work limits to allow her standing and walking 50% of her work time, otherwise sitting. Recheck in 2 weeks with expectations to resume normal activities then.

FINAL DIAGNOSIS:

Right leg contusions.

October 15, 2014.
