I was stationed there for two years, July 2011-July 2013. During my time here, I deployed to Afghanistan for 7 months from November 15, 2011-June 5, 2012. Our mission there was to build dirt roads for coalition forces and local populous for faster and safer travel in the region. Additionally, we built up and tore down forward operating bases and patrol outposts. After my time in Okinawa I was sent to 1st LAR (light armored reconnaissance) in Camp Pendleton, California. This was during the start of the draw down of pulling forces out of Afghanistan and we only did training operations in support of 1st Division.
