Job duties with mile high coatings included assisting the foreman and prepping concrete floors with 4 ½ inch grinders and 7 inch hand grinders. After grinding the floors to a salt and pepper look Epoxy, Polyaspartic and concrete stain will then be laid down for a base coat. After basing the floor the main coat is put down with either vinyl chips and or quarts. Once dried the final layers come in to play. Depending on what the customer wants we would lay down either 2 coats of clear coat or one coat of clear and one coat of satin. The last duty of this job was to make sure the customer's property is clean and to make sure they are satisfied with the job.

Welder/ Fabricator

As a welder it was my duty to weld steel walls together and fit pipe for 12 by 12 foot buildings and 12 by 24 foot buildings. These building were made to extract oil from tanks. When the oil is extracted it is then tested through out these steel buildings. You are able to check the temperature, count it and much more. Getting buildings done and ready for the QC (quality check) was a huge part of this job. We were expected to work anything from 55-60 hours a week. Forklift operating and pallet jacks were used often. Also used bands saws, hand grinders, and more power tools.
