


# YOUR SOCIAL SECURITY CARD

The Social Security number is yours to use as their own. Do not give it out and your number is not for sale. You should only use your Social Security number on applications for U.S. government benefits. Show your card and number on other evidence of your identity. Some private organizations may require your Social Security number for their own records. Do not give out your Social Security information from this card. Any government agency that asks for your Social Security number voluntarily, its use is not required. If you are an employer, your card is VALID FOR EMPLOYMENT. If you are an employer, your card should be marked "VALID FOR EMPLOYMENT" to authorize employment. You should only use your Social Security number on applications for U.S. government benefits or are about to apply for a U.S. government benefit.
