### **PROGRESS REPORT**

#### **CONSULTANTS:**

1. Longmont United Hospital ER on June 20, 2017.

**CHIEF COMPLAINT:** Follow up right elbow traumatic laceration after walking into a fan, improving.

**SUBJECTIVE:** The patient returns for a reevaluation. He states that he continues to see improvement. He has been in a work-conditioning program and will complete this tomorrow. He does notice some continued weakness and soreness occasionally, especially with pressure on his elbow. He added that he will be seeing the orthopedist, Dr. Olenick tomorrow. He denies any swelling. No numbness or tingling.

**REVIEW OF SYSTEMS:** Ten-point review of systems were reviewed, noted, and filed.

#### **OBJECTIVE:**

**VITAL SIGNS:** Blood pressure 100/78. Pulse of 74. Pulse oximetry 97%. Temperature 97.4.

**GENERAL:** He is in no acute distress. Alert and oriented x3. Mood and affect appropriate. Ambulating without difficulty.

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LUNGS: Breathing unlabored. No respiratory distress.

EXTREMITIES: Right elbow: The laceration sites have well healed. No swelling. No effusion. He has full mobility of the elbow. He has good strength against resistance. Mild weakness against resisted supination. Sensation to light touch intact. Capillary refill brisk.

HEART: Regular rate and rhythm.

LUNGS: Clear to auscultation.

ABDOMEN: Nondistended.

DIAGNOSIS: Right elbow laceration status post repair, improving.

TREATMENT PLAN:

1. He will complete his work-conditioning program.
2. Follow up with Dr. Olenick, orthopedist, tomorrow.
3. I feel that he should be able to return for a trial period of full duties starting on Thursday, October 19, 2017, as he does have scheduled appointments with therapy and the orthopedist tomorrow.
4. I will have him return back here in 2 weeks for a reevaluation. If there are no setbacks, I anticipate discharge at that time.

He has no further questions and understands and agrees with the treatment plan.
