I began my position as a line cook working primarily night shifts (5pm-2:30am), with the understanding that I would be trained as a manager soon thereafter. I spent about two months working closes, learning how to bake and work the line. After two months, I began being trained as a manager, however turmoil within the company resulted in the loss of key personnel and a significant drop in the labor budget. Although I was trained as a manager, they couldn't afford to pay me the salary of one, so I maintained my role as a backup manager and sort of shift leader. I decided to leave the company because they couldn't give me enough hours, but also because the owner did not exercise safe business practices and did not uphold many of his promises of improvement.
