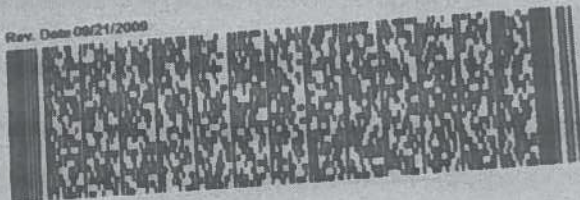

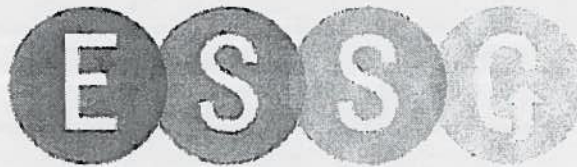

INJURY MANAGEMENT PROGRAM

Injured Worker's Responsibilities

As your employer, we are concerned about your full recovery. Reasonable and necessary medical care will be paid for any compensable work injury. Medically authorized time away from work will be reimbursed in accordance with the **State of Minnesota workers' compensation laws**. Wherever possible light duty restrictions imposed as a result of your injury will be accommodated.

RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE INJURED WORKER:

Minnesota Rule Sec. 5221.0430, Subp. 1 requires that you choose one primary health care provider. Subpart 2 places limitations on your right to change primary health care providers. Discuss with your employer any change in health care provider.

Attend all scheduled appointments. While on physical limitations, visits should be a minimum of once every two weeks. Failure to have current medical support for disability may result in termination of benefits. Schedule your next appointment immediately after your doctor visit, before you leave the clinic if possible.

Obtain a Report of Workability from your physician at every appointment, a minimum of once every two weeks. M.R. 5221.0420 requires that your physician cooperate with return to work planning and that you be released to return to work at the earliest appropriate time.

Immediately following your appointment, provide a copy of the report to the designated employer representative. You should deliver this in person so that changes in work restrictions may be addressed and any questions answered.

Follow all physical restrictions at home and at work.

Report to work and perform physically suitable tasks as assigned. These may or may not be in your regular department. The work may or may not be on your usual shift.

Maintain regular, weekly, communication with your employer if you are unable to return to work. Contact your employer a minimum of after every visit with your primary health care provider. Keep the claims representative advised of your status.

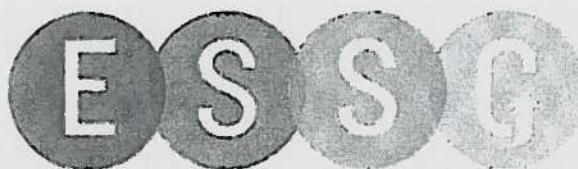
Notify your employer immediately of any new injuries or conditions that impact your physical condition.

If it is necessary to miss scheduled work due to a work injury, you must be seen by your primary health care provider the same day in order to receive compensation for the time away from work. The physician must complete a Report of Workability.

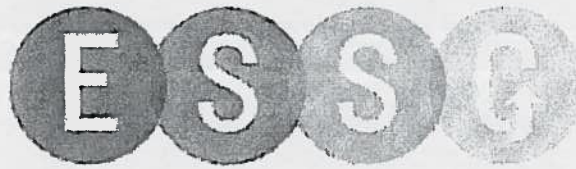

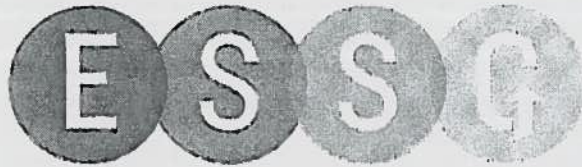

And, you can file a complaint if you are punished or discriminated against for acting as a "whistleblower" under the OSH Act or 13 other federal statutes for which OSHA has jurisdiction, or for refusing to work when faced with imminent danger of death or serious injury and there is insufficient time for OSHA to inspect. Retaliation or reprisal taken against anyone who has expressed concern about workplace safety is illegal.
