I was solely in charge of the utv fleet which usually consists of 18 various machines of which id carry out monthly inspections. In my inspection I'd be extremely thorough with the air filtration, oil changes, and brakes and calipers. On a sold out day 12 machines are rented for the entire 8 hour day with 7-14 different drivers through rugged terrain. I was in charge of all inventory for the spare parts and fluids that spanned across 3 different makes and 5 different models. If any machine was damaged on a tour I'd then retrieve the UTV however possible and assess damage and charge the attendant that damaged said machine only cost in parts. I would then fix the machine in a quick manner to get it back in rotation. I'd log all my actions in a paper log then transfer a digital copy. I've also sold some UTV for the company. I would still be employed at this fantastic family owned company however with issues concerning Pennsylvania residency I'm moving back to Indiana. When I started here there was about six running machines maybe 3 dependable but in the short time I was there the company grew so much and I gave a 6 week notice to end employment so I could efficiently train my replacement/s.

I had to do constant and precise checks to adhere to FDA guidelines due to my parts being implanted into the sternum and cranium of human beings.
