I worked On-site at a multi-million dollar estate, doing interior and exterior maintenance, including landscaping maintenance and additions. Was responsible for finding and controlling workers up to a six man crew for certain projects around the estate. I was the means of communication between outside contractors and the owners of the estate. I was there for 8 months helping prepare the estate to go up on the market.

Projects included:

Complete demolition and renovation of the grass. Approximately 8,000 sq/f of dead grass torn up and completely new irrigation installed. The Dripline system failed through the yard so was converted to pop-up sprinklers.

Irrigation for planting areas needed to be replaced and leaks found and fixed. and new drip lines installed where it was necessary.

All landscaped areas with plants needed to be cleaned up and trimmed.

Exterior Landscape lights moved and rewired.

Redrawing of the blueprint of the estate including additions to the irrigation, water lines and sprinklers, and additions to the exterior low voltage wire for the landscape lighting.
