MANAGEMENT

- Working at JM Flooring as a tile installer there are laborers available to help during the daily installs. I

had 2 laborers that were available to work with and I taught them both how to grout and helped manage them in their daily chores when the supervisor on the site was unavailable during the day. I did this on an as-needed basis.

COMMUNICATION

- I communicate well with others. I had the opportunity at JM Flooring to train employees to do tasks that I had already mastered. I learned through this process that not every one learns the same but as long as you can communicate either through direct instruction or through physically showing them with instruction they will open up and ask questions and work at doing the task right.

LEADERSHIP

- I used my leadership skills at JM Flooring through learning by example. I took initiative to show the laborers that in the mornings we take 30 minutes to set up with all the tools. If tools needed cleaned then I showed them what would be needed for the day and how to clean them. In the afternoons about 45 minutes before the days end I would start cleaning up. This meant any of the installers who need trash cleaned up or tools stored away and were still installing and would be staying late to clean up needed an extra hand. Through this process they learned initiative and they also got a better understanding of the installation process of tile.
