Hydro Resources-Fort Lupton, CO-manager at the time of hire Fred Rothauge-water well services, large scale water projects for state and local municipalities-from Texas, New Mexico, Colorado and Utah. Drilling and sinking of pipe for fracking purposes- oil and gas-some drinking water-most common pipe diameter 12" but could vary up to 48". Up to depths of 2500' deep.

Job description-Weld Foreman shop and field related. Directly responsible of all water well pipe going into the hole and welding all joints. Demanded consistent and precise scheduling-this was a very challenging job-mixture of steel and stainless steel perforated piping. Normally, most joints are 40' sections but again could vary depending on the engineers findings just after well was drilled and logged.

Once started and pipe was cleared to go into the hole it was my call from then on-I had total control from that point forward. Once started these wells usually take 30 to 40 hrs straight to complete and that is around the clock.

You simply learn to take breaks but no sleep during that time period-not until the job is completed. Once the well was secured it normally took me 2 days of sleep to recover from it. Before I came to this company the normal length of stay for a welder in my position was 6 months-I lasted for 2 years and the only reason that I left was the fact that managers changed just as quickly. Pay was great, unfortunately I had to deal with too many changes within management each time a new one came on board and we did not always see eye to eye. During my tenure every well that I participated in was successful-not all of them are.
