August 2015 - May 2017

Initially hired on as Temporary Lead during the EDC (electronic distribution center) peak season. Responsible for assigning job duties to about 30 temporary associates and worked as bulk item processor during that time. Certified on a Crown PE 4500 walkie truck (capable of hauling two pallets at once). I then transferred into the receiving department where the daily duties consisted of being assigned to a dock door range with about 3-5 doors to be unloaded throughout the day. The majority of freight that came in was mixed product, which had to be broken down, counted and processed separately, all on a RF handgun and mobile computer cart. This required a fair amount of attention to the accuracy and condition of the freight coming in. Any damages were documented and shorted accordingly to the final count on the manifest. This position required training and certification on three power equipment trucks including the Crown RC forklift, which had frequent use of clamp and slip-sheet attachments (all stand-up forklifts). Safety was a high priority. The whole building is a "clean as you go" facility to help minimize accidents.

Maintained an off site warehouse for receiving and storing excess inventory, and also for preparing and staging bulk orders to be shipped out according to a pick list. Floor loaded shipping containers came in and the product had to be separated and counted by hand. Towards the end of the position responsibilities included labeling and transferring all inventory to an out of state location. Main use of power equipment was an LP sit down forklift, and seldom use of a stand up electric lift. For inventory that was unstable for shipment I was also tasked with building housing crates so the material could ship safely (miter saw/power tools).

Inspect incoming/outgoing goods for damage or alteration; inbounds were checked, counted; Accuracies/inaccuracies were noted on the bill of lading. Daily outgoing transfer orders were picked/staged and shipped to a local company who utilized the cold storage for consumable ingredients. Being a storage facility that housed food, daily perimeter checks were completed to ensure security, and limit pest problems. Freight was handled with a sit down electric forklift.
