#### Harassing Calls From Debt Collectors Options

Collection agencies must stop contacting a consumer known to be represented by a lawyer, as long as the lawyer responds to the collection agency's inquiries. This behavior can come in many different forms, including repetitive phone calls meant to annoy or harass the borrower, use of obscene or threatening language or making threats of violence. However, it may be hard to figure out when the clock on that period starts to run or can be restarted (for example, a partial payment of the debt may restart the clock), and a debt collector that is time-barred from suing you may still send you collection notices, call you to try to get you to pay, or report your debt to credit reporting companies. Tell them why it's difficult for you, and try to work out a modified payment plan that reduces your payments to a more manageable level. For example, assume that your payments on a loan were late in January, but that you caught up in February. Then, list your "fixed" expenses-those that are the same each month-such as your mortgage payments or your rent, car payments, or insurance premiums.

Put a fraud alert on your credit report and get copies to see if there are other debts that aren't yours. Because it is FRAUD. That does happen. But when their retainer fee is \$5000, you can be sure that they are not being hired to track down and harass people who have debts less than \$25,000. Under debt management, debts are restructured into a single, predictable, stable payment. Never admit to owing the debt or divulge whether or not you intend on making any payments. In addition, the FDCPA prohibits debt collector from making false, deceptive, or misleading representations to consumers when attempting to collect on debts. And debt collectors don't get to set the financial priorities for your family. They have

contacted your family and/or friends and told them about your debt or tried to collect your debt from them. Get the debt taken off your credit file. Collectors get commissions -- usually 30 to 50% -- on money they bring in, which often double or triple their salaries. Most third-party collection agencies work on a fee or percentage arrangement with clients who are owed the money. Even if they are successful in court, there is still no guarantee the person will pay them.

If they do, you will have to take action to clear your name or you will risk major problems with applying for credit, such as a car loan, mortgage or even an apartment rental. The debt collection agencies have no legal power of entry at all. Also, Illinois patients have the legal right to demand the collection agency stop all calls; it is best to exercise these rights in writing and send the letter through a traceable mailing method such as certified mail. Also, don't pay money you know you don't owe just to stop the harassment, because this can be considered an admission that the debt is yours. Zombie debt is not a new concept, but it has been receiving more attention as a result of changes that occurred in the 1990s. In the 1990s, credit card companies started actively trying to earn more interest by offering cards to customers who didn't pay off their balances in full at the end of the month.

But they can call you at work. Consumers can request that debt collectors communicate with them only in writing or cease communication altogether. If the company is harassing you about debt that is not yours, send the company a letter requesting them to stop contacting you. Additional forms of harassing behavior under the FDCPA includes calling the debtor without telling him or her who the person calling is, contacting the debtor at his or her place of business after being told to not contact him or her there, and communicating with third-parties to share information regarding the debt owed and the debtor. What they are not allowed to do is contacting third party people like friends, family and so on.

Use deception to make the debtor accept collect calls or pay for telegrams. "We've always warned not to believe anybody who calls you claiming to be from the IRS because the IRS doesn't call trying to collect delinquent taxes. "There are so many reasons why it's a bad idea that the IRS has been forced to use private debt collectors," said Chi Chi Wu, staff attorney with the National Consumer Law Center. Why? Nobody actually reviews your case. The IRS says it will not assign accounts to private collection agencies involving certain types of taxpayers, including: minors, those in combat zones, victims of tax-related identity theft, accounts that are subject to installment agreements or classified as an innocent spouse case. Under the FDCPA, debt collectors are prohibited from disclosing or discussing the nature of a consumer's debt with third parties. At any point in the above process, if you believe a debt collector isn't following the rules, is contacting you to the level of harassment, or is contacting you about a debt you don't owe, there are a few places to lodge a complaint. If you can explain your dire situation early on without ignoring them, then they are more willing to cooperate with you. It's widely considered that more than 10 calls per month are considered harassment and you may have grounds for compensation. If collectors are calling incessantly, calling workplaces when they know it is not allowed by employers, jeopardizing a consumer's job or harassing debtors' friends or neighbors, a cease communication letter can be sent. Borrowers may choose to bargain for better repayment terms, to have the debt reported as paid in full on their credit reports or to have calls cease altogether.

After hearing evidence of the use of abusive and unfair practices by debt collectors and the negative consequences that these practices have on consumers' finances, marriages, employment, and health, Congress enacted the Fair Debt Collection Practices Act (FDCPA).
