

# Can Debt Collectors Sue You In Texas

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Again breaching these laws can land debt collectors in a serious trouble and in worst case scenarios, their licence can be suspended temporarily. Citing privacy issues, Chrysler Financial declined to comment about the specifics of Ringstaffs case. Chrysler Financial, however, noted the company is not considered a debt collector as defined by the federal FDCPA, even though the company collects its own accounts, according to Amber Gowen, a spokesperson for the company. After her husband underwent heart surgery in 2007, Ringstaff tried to refinance her vehicle loan but Chrysler Financial turned her down. Alternatively, you could consider making a complaint to VCAT, which has the power to award up to \$10,000 compensation if you can prove that you have suffered humiliation or distress as a result of a course of conduct that is a prohibited debt collection practice. This type of order can not be used with third parties, even if the third party holding property of the debtor can be served with a copy of the order of execution and the notification of withdrawal. The Act also restricts the practices of many creditors such as mortgage lenders, and grants broad investigative and enforcement powers to the state attorney general.
