

Collections Harassment Law

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Question: Does the Emergency Act require creditors to halt all activity relative to the repossession of a vehicle? The debt collectors are accused of threatening people with criminal prosecution if they didn't pay their debts, harassing the consumers, using profane language, and trying to collect debts that were not owed, all in violation of the Fair Debt Collection Practices Act and the Dodd-Frank Act. Here in the United States, the Fair Debt Collection Practices Act protects debtors from predatory collection tactics, and many other countries have used this act as a model to create their own legislation to outlaw these unethical types of collections. When it comes to collecting a consumer debt, individuals, businesses and attorneys' must be familiar with the Florida Consumer Collection Practices Act ("FCCPA") and its federal counterpart, the Fair Debt Collection Practices Act ("FDCPA"). " Thus, while Florida law does not mandate that its state courts obey federal court precedent, Florida courts will likely look to federal precedent for guidance. Even though it is against the law for bill collectors to use certain tactics to collect a debt, some do it anyway.

1. Debt Collection and Federal Law: The Federal Fair Debt Collection Practices Act (FDCPA) generally governs how debt collectors may legally operate nationally, as well as in Michigan. Because of this, debt collectors make mistakes. If you owe money that is past due, or simply if the debt collector thinks you owe money that is past due, they will call you. These are folks whose whole job is to get you to pay back money that you owe. So if their only job is to get money from you, how do you get them to stop? A debt collection agency can never ask you to pay more than what was in the original loan arrangement (principal, interest rate or other fees). Do I have to pay a debt that's considered time-barred? Before seeking legal help on harassment cases during debt collection attempts, it is recommended that you should first consult with the laws in your state. However, even with the most law-abiding debt collection officer, you may experience some form of harassment and in cases like this, you may be able to seek help from the law. The Act was created with the purpose of enforcing the stand of the law against harassment during the debt collection and recovery process. To further enforce this stand, the Fair Debt Collection Practice Act (FDCPA) was created. If any debt collector calls repetitively, this is treated as harassment under the FDCPA. A debt collector can't call you at your workplace: Under the FDCPA, a debt collector is not allowed to contact you at your workplace after knowing that you are not comfortable receiving such calls there.

Often, however, debt collection agencies do an end run around the law and don't notify the consumer (that's what the New York City study revealed). A common complaint is that collection agencies do not play by the rules. Debt collection agencies must follow the same rules as the original lender, which means they have the same legal rights. So how do you regain your power as a consumer from the collection agencies? If a debt collector uses any false, deceptive, or misleading representation or means in connection with the collection of a debt that's not listed above, the FDCPA will most likely still offer the consumer protection from it. Be advised that any further telephone calls from your company may be recorded and used in evidence and I expect this harassment to cease immediately. Pursue legal action. If enough time passes and they give you a written warning of impending legal action, the debt collection agency can indeed sue you if they see fit. Be sure to note the date and time of the call as well. Please note that the FDCPA typically does not apply to the original creditor. Keep detailed written records of what is happening - note down the name of any person you speak to, the date and the time, a brief description of what happened and the names of any witnesses. If a debt collector threatens

to garnish your wages without the filing of a civil lawsuit, be sure to find out exactly who you are speaking to, what company they are with, their address and return phone number. Consumers should also keep track of phone calls and communications: when the call happened, who called, and what was said or not said. After this, they're required to send you another letter, this time informing you of how much you owe, who they are, what creditor held the debt and other such details. Another exception is that the agency may notify the debtor if the debt collector or the creditor intends to take some specific actions. Can a collection agency contact any other person in debt? You can negotiate the amount owed, the number of payments and the payment date. Collections are a continuation of debt owed and can stay on your credit report for up to 7 years from the date the debt first became delinquent and was not brought current. Can I negotiate with debt collectors? Collectors are not permitted to threaten you with action they can not or will not take; thus, they can't threaten to sue or file charges against you, garnish wages, take property, cause job loss, or ruin your credit, as this goes against phone harassment laws.

While the FDCPA allows a collector to add interest if your original agreement calls for the addition of interest during collection proceedings, or the addition of such interest is allowed under state law, it is not necessary to spend the money or risk your checking account for any of the above methods. The Federal Trade Commission states that you can do this by writing a letter the collections agency that asks them to stop contacting you. Write a letter to the collector telling them to stop contacting you. Within thirty days of receiving the written notice, send a letter to the collection agency stating that you do not owe the money. Send the letter via certified mail and request a return receipt so you can verify that the agency received your correspondence. Upon receipt of the letter, the collection agency may only contact you to tell you that they will not contact you anymore or to let you know if they are going to take a specific action against you, like take you to court over the debt you owe.
