

# Debt Collection Agency Harassment

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Just tell them to stop. The first thing is to understand that there's a big difference between debt collection agencies (who are usually private firms) and enforcement officers (known as either High Court Enforcement Officers or County Court Bailiffs). That depends on the facts of your situation because there's a difference between trying to collect on a debt and harassment. 2001), holding that "in the absence of a threat of litigation or actual litigation, no violation of the FDCPA has occurred when a debt collector attempts to collect on a potentially time-barred debt that is otherwise valid." Many courts have agreed with this line, including the Third Circuit in *Huertas v. Galaxy Asset Mgmt.*, 641 F.3d 28 (3d Cir. 2011). Just because the lawyer says that he or she will go in front of the judge and you don't have to, does not make it a good idea. But don't panic if you have debts in collection - and don't ignore the debt collectors either. Secured debt are debts which you put up against a valuable asset, for example, your house as a promise to pay the debt.

Creditors know. Collectibles know. Say no to creditors. But you do not have anyone trying to collect overdue bills. Inquire about a payment plan to bring the bill up to date; most providers would prefer any payment arrangement from the patient or his family, rather than no guarantee of payment while the collection agency tries to collect. The PFD letter allows you to negotiate repayment of your debt on your terms and not the bill collectors. Are you being chased by debt collectors, do not give them any information. The federal Fair Debt Collection Practices Act states that creditors or collection agencies have the right to call you at home or work to collect a debt unless you ask that they stop calling. A debt collector doesn't have any right to your personal financial information, and certainly not over the phone. Once you've confirmed that the debt is yours and the collector is legitimate, it can make sense to look into hardship programs, Kuehnhoff says.

Information about a lawsuit or an unpaid judgment against you can be reported for seven years or until the statute of limitations runs out, whichever is longer. Thus, you can contact FTC to report against the debt collector who had harassed you or violated the FDCPA rules. These companies are notorious for taking advantage of unwary consumers who make verbal agreements over the telephone.

The good news is that the negative impact to your scores can decrease over time, until the account drops off or is removed from your reports. At the same time, collection agencies are counselors to financially-strapped consumers, assisting them with fulfilling their financial obligations to the best of their ability. The FDCPA can be your best friend when you are facing the relentless pursuit of a collection agency. Suddenly you are facing threats that could seem abusive, deceptive, or just plain unfair. If you're facing a debt buyer or collector situation, you don't have to deal with this on your own. The reason you're getting calls, and will eventually get letters, from a collection agency is because they are trying to collect money from you for a defaulted credit card debt. The FDCPA protects consumers by prohibiting debt or bill collectors from using abusive behavior when attempting to collect. Debt collectors may not be able to sue you to collect on old (time-barred) debts, but they may still try to collect on those debts. If you get behind in paying your bills and a debt collector is assigned to collect your money, the experience can become your worst nightmare. Debt collection agencies buy charged off debts at pennies on the dollar.

If you hire a lawyer, he will send the collection agency a cease-and-desist letter and the collector must contact the attorney and not you. A creditor can pass the debtor's default profile on to a DCA (debt collection agency) after writing a letter informing the debtor. If a debtor pays off a collection account, the item may remain on the debtor's credit report but must be marked "paid". If the debtor wins a court case under the act, the debt collector must pay the lawyer's fees. In fact, Toyota now is being sued for fraud because of its unlawful actions in an earlier case. The debt collector says everything they can to make you feel bad about yourself, often trying to shame you into paying the debt that you would gladly pay if you could afford it. An expired statute simply means your debt collector couldn't win a lawsuit against you in civil court. By making a payment, you once again make yourself vulnerable for a lawsuit. If a debt collector threatens to take action that isn't legal under state or federal law, that's a violation of the Fair Debt Collection Practices Act and can leave the collector open to a lawsuit.

The best way to do this is by taking down handwritten notes during or very shortly after a phone call was made. Ask for the name of the company, address, the caller name, fax and phone number, amount owed, and the name of the creditor who passed your account to them. When you have payments due, every phone call or knock on the door can be nerve-wracking as you wonder if this is the moment debt collectors come to take away your possessions. If a collector contacts you about a debt, you may want to talk to them at least once to see if you can resolve the matter - even if you don't think you owe the debt, can't repay it immediately, or think that the collector is contacting you by mistake. A consumer collection agency may not continue to contact you if, within 30 days after you receive the written notice, you send them a letter stating you do not owe money. This written letter must detail to whom you owe the debt, the amount and offer instructions on how you can dispute the debt.

Although debt collectors are allowed to contact third parties, they are not allowed to ask a third party to give a message to the consumer. Do: Make contact via email, SMS, Facebook or telephone call. The law also bans telephone representatives from making solicitation calls to your home before 8 am or after 9 pm. "There are so many reasons why it's a bad idea that the IRS has been forced to use private debt collectors," said Chi Chi Wu, staff attorney with the National Consumer Law Center. Why? Nobody actually reviews your case. The IRS says it will not assign accounts to private collection agencies involving certain types of taxpayers, including: minors, those in combat zones, victims of tax-related identity theft, accounts that are subject to installment agreements or classified as an innocent spouse case.
