Further, I believe that the courts are seeing that when a collector's calls go unanswered, the only reason for a collector to keep calling is to make the person so annoyed that they'll answer and pay just to get the calls to stop.

These programs seek to provide a consolidated monthly payment that the credit counseling agency then pays to all lenders over a set period of time. The Fair Debt Collection Practices Act prohibits a wide range of unlawful collection methods that third-party debt collectors use often in their attempts to collect debts. The Consumer Financial Protection Bureau (CFPB) has proposed a rule governing third-party debt collectors. In addition, companies are not allowed to require consent as a prerequisite to purchasing goods or services and are prohibited from collecting cell phone numbers through unrelated transactions, incoming phone calls or third-party contracts. First and foremost, you should write to the debt collection agency and request a copy of the original credit agreement to make sure they are actually chasing the right debt, and that it is legitimate. Oklahoma laws provide limited protection for debtors against original creditors calling to collect a debt. An original creditor may pass your debt to a collection agency, sell it to a debt buyer, or file a lawsuit against you. A lien would mean that if you wanted to sell or refinance your home at some point, you would have to repay your debt first. If the debt collector unlawfully stalks the debtor and causes the debtor to be harassed, alarmed or distressed in the process and if the debt collector did so know that such an effect would have been caused he may be guilty of an offence. The Federal Fair Debt Collection Practices Act allows you to collect penalties for these actions. In fact, the federal Fair Debt Collection Practices Act (FDCPA) specifically outlines behaviors that are prohibited. Another federal consumer protection statute, the Fair Credit Reporting Act (FCRA) gives consumers a way to challenge inaccurate information on their credit reports. Debt collectors must abide by federal laws in responding to your request for verification.

Most of my clients owe the debt being collected, but because of financial circumstances, or a dispute over the goods or services, they cannot pay it. If the debt doesn't belong to you, you can dispute it. A roommate tells you a debt collector called asking for you. 1. This early intervention through the use of a debt refinance loan will prevent you from having to pay outrageous interest rates, late payment fees and charges which will only complicate your already shaky financial status. So when should you consider seeking out a debt consolidation loan or refinance? Before you consider paying the debt, know that you have a right to request that the bill collector provide adequate proof of the (alleged) debt. Although the Federal Trade Commission does not tolerate the harassment of debtors, some debt collectors still employ illegal debt collecting practices against consumers. Within 5 days of the initial communication, the debt collector must provide the debtor with "clear and conspicuous written notification" that debt collectors are prohibited from engaging in "abusive, deceptive, and unfair debt collection efforts" under the FDCPA.
