The FDCPA does permit debt collectors to contact your family in order to find out what your residential address is, your phone number, or your work address. With a few exceptions, Section 805(b) of the FDCPA prohibits a debt collector from discussing a person's debts with third parties. Fortunately, the Government has strict recommendations around how often a debt collector can contact you. Often, when you ask for validation, the debt collector will simply stop trying to collect the debt because it can't validate it. The fair debt collections law prohibits soliciting post-dated checks if they will be used to threaten consumers with criminal prosecution for bouncing checks.
