By law, the collector must inform you of your right to dispute the debt and provide written verification if you dispute it in writing. Once the collector receives your letter, it may not contact you again, except to say there will be no further contact or to notify you that the agency or the creditor intends to take certain specific actions.

If you pay off a debt, make sure you have a letter that states the debt is paid. However, there are some tell-tale signs that an alleged debt collector is actually a scammer or fake agency. If the debt owed isn't yours, write a letter asking for the debt to be validated, which means that the debt collection agency has to obtain proof that the debt is yours --- a signed contract, for example. Most of the time, unsecured debt consolidation loans have a long period of time repayment. However, the customer and collector can agree to speak outside of this time frame. At this point, you can threaten to write the Federal Trade Commission as well as threaten legal action, if they don't comply. Being free from your debts will be well worth the effort and sacrifice. As a recent article in Reuters points out, companies that buy old debt, typically for "pennies on the dollar," often attempt to collect those debts from consumers even if the statute of limitations has run out. Many of those consumers simply do not owe the debts for which they are being contacted, while other consumers do owe debts but are being treated unfairly by the collection companies. Debts in collection are usually loaded with such interest. Debt collection companies like Midland Funding LLC are required to abide by the Fair Debt Collection Practices Act (FDCPA), and they cannot use unfair or fraudulent methods to collect debts . That question arose in a recent case against Midland Funding LLC, Midland Credit Management, Inc., and Encore Capital Group, Inc. Illinois consumers got a win in this case, which involved aggrieved consumers seeking class action certification, according to a recent article in Reuters . The Bureau recently released an annual summary report that details some of the actions taken last year that helped to protect consumers against unscrupulous debt collectors.

If the debt is legitimate, it does not mean the person calling is entitled to collect the debt. 2. A person trying to collect a debt communicates directly with you after notification from an attorney representing you that all further communications relative to the debt should be addressed to the lawyer. If the collection agency can't prove you owe the money, ask the agency to stop attempting to collect the debt and to also remove the negative entry from your credit history. A collection agency also frees you up to focus on running and growing your enterprise. Debt collection harassment can take various forms, including embarrassing visits by debt collection agents. It is likely that they purchased your outstanding debt from your creditors at pennies on the dollar and pivoted right to harassment and lawsuits to try to strong-arm you into paying. Why do I need a debt collection harassment attorney ? Have you received calls from a debt collector or creditor for a debt owed by another person? Consumers owe more debt than ever, have fewer assets than ever with which to pay it, and debt collectors and their lawyers are getting more aggressive by the day in trying to collect it.

They can charge interest and fees if you are behind on your payments. "The reason you don't see it very often is that it's a very expensive thing to pursue in court and consumers can put a stop to it overnight with one bankruptcy filing," Bovee says. Doing so will eventually put you in a pretty nice group-the 242 million adults who don't have a debt in collections. In some cases, those violations could put money in your pocket. Know what money you owe and to whom. It's important to know a "manager" at a collection agency won't advocate for your rights. It's also important to note that some creditors can garnish wages and seize certain assets without filing a lawsuit and getting a judgment. For one, the laws in half of the states require lenders to get court approval before they can foreclose on your home and foreclosure can be a lengthy process. On the flip side, a creditor may intentionally give a consumer the impression that an existing debt is not being disputed in cases where a dispute is already in place or ongoing. The Fair Debt Collections Practices Act dictates what is construed as abusive and deceitful debt collections practices at the consumer level. Some collection agencies require collectors to meet certain quotas in terms of the number of collections they get within specified time periods, while others may receive bonuses for meeting or exceeding a certain quota. The statute of limitations is the time established by your state in which a creditor can sue you for an unpaid debt. 1. The debt is old and statute barred - that is, the debt collector or lender is outside the time provided by the law to sue for the debt. An outside bill collector is someone, other than the person to whom you owe money, who is trying to get you to pay the debt. Also, junk debt buyers purchase debts that are outside the statute of limitations for lawsuit (legal enforcement of the debt) but not outside the statute of limitations for reporting the debt on your credit report! Should they continue any more attempts to collect payment on debts you can file a complaint with the FTC and pursue the case legally.

The FDCPA requires debt collectors to inform consumers that they are attempting to collect a debt. Is it legal for a debt collector to call your cell phone? Your cell phone is a means to contact you - and they can use that means to try to collect a debt.
