

How To Dispute Debt Collection Letter

To get around this, it's best to let the call go to voicemail if you don't want to talk to the debt collection agency. Request written notice of the debt, which should include the amount you owe, the name of the original creditor and information on how to dispute it if you don't believe it's valid. When asked, they must identify themselves to you with their name and the name of their collection agency. For instance, they must always disclose their organization's name and their real identity. 5. The outside sources - often called third parties - can generally be contacted no more than once.
