If six years and a day pass since your last activity and your debt collector hasn't brought an action against you to collect on your outstanding credit card debt, that debt collector can no longer sue you to repay what you owe. "Most important in the analysis is the assessment of facts closely relating to ordinary concepts of regularity, including (1) the absolute number of debt collection communications issued, and/or collection-related litigation matters pursued, over the relevant period(s), (2) the frequency of such communications and/or litigation activity, including whether any patterns of such activity are discernible, (3) whether the entity has personnel specifically assigned to work on debt collection activity, (4) whether the entity has systems or contractors in place to facilitate such activity, and (5) whether the activity is undertaken in connection with ongoing client relationships with entities that have retained the lawyer or firm to assist in the collection of outstanding consumer debt obligations. Technically, the 30-day validation period begins when you first become aware of the debt. You first should realize that any debt that is older than 7 years has expired and is beyond the statute of limitations.

You get a warning when you call that those calls are being recorded. When you take this call at work, you can inform the collector that you cannot receive these personal calls at work. Receiving calls while you are working is both inconvenient and against the rules at most employers tell them you are not allowed to receive call at work and hang up. You will call them back when it is more convenient and hang up. If they call you back immediately it is harassment. It is never convenient to receive a call for a collection agency and you can tell them that. It is also a violation of the FDCPA if they don't know how to get in contact with you if they tell the people they contact they are from a collection agency. The Administration of Justice Act 1970 S.40 makes it a Criminal Offence for a creditor or a creditor's agent (often a debt collection agency) to make demands (for money), which are aimed at causing 'alarm, distress or humiliation'.

One of the most significant changes made by these new regulations is with respect to required disclosures when collecting on a consumer debt from someone residing in NYC. It's important for consumer debtors residing in New York City to know that they have the benefit of protections under both the Federal laws and the local regulations. Beyond this there have been new regulations with regards to collection and account specific disclosures. Over the course of the 60 days the collector must compile information to substantiate the debt, such as: copy of a court judgement, a copy of the original signed contract, the account of the initial statement from the original creditor, the chain of title of the debt, as well as records of previous settlement offers. The Fair Debt Collection Practices Act (FDCPA), 1978, is a United States statute added as Title VIII of the Consumer Credit Protection Act. FDCPA states that violating the rules could lead to an individual seeking help from the law. The bill would prohibit debt collectors from contacting a consumer electronically without their consent, after their consent has been withdrawn, or more frequently than they consent to be contacted; any such contact would constitute harassment under the FDCPA. The FDCPA provides many examples of what a debt collector cannot do because it is considered

harassment. For FDCPA purposes, the distinction between a "loan servicer" and a "debt collector" depends on whether the loan was in "default" at the time it was obtained. The answer depends on when the debt was assigned to the loan servicer for collection. If a debt collection law firm violates the FDCPA, you can sue for statutory damages up to \$1,000.00, actual damages (like pain and suffering) and the debt collection attorney may have to pay for your attorney. A debt collection may not place a call to the debtor if the call will cost the debtor toll charges (in most other countries recipients of telephone calls are not charged, so this issue does not arise). Even with a collection agency, suggest settling the debt for less than the full amount due. The most common examples are with mortgages and student loans but loan or debt servicers are also used in connection with medical bills and even gym memberships.

Can you stop a debt collector from contacting you? The collection agency must also contact you in writing regarding the debt. List the name, mailing address and telephone number of the collection agency. Provisions under the FDCPA and the TCPA also let you tell a debt collector that certain numbers such as your cell phone or work number is off limits. The less you tell them, the better. For example, a debt collector cannot tell a third party, like the debt holder's boss, about the debt in the course of trying to collect it. It provides basic collection services like demand letters, calls, and payment reminders, as well as more advanced services, such as first- and third-party accounts receivable management options and skip tracing.
