

# Legal Letters For Debt Collection

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Make sure you approach a charity such as StepChange, National DebtLine or Christians Against Poverty, as they can help you with free debt management plans. Know Your Rights in Debt Collection explains how you can assert yourself when creditors call, and your rights if you are being hounded about a debt. Collectors cannot misrepresent themselves on the phone, nor can they threaten to take any action that they do not intend to take (for example, because collection agencies cannot put you in jail, they cannot threaten jail time for an unpaid debt). However, Canadian legislation does set a statute of limitations on the amount of time a creditor has to sue you based on acknowledgement of the debt. While you might be able to dodge debt collectors in the short term, let your debts spiral out of control and you could soon find your car and other property seized and sold in order to recover your debts, or bankruptcy proceedings commenced against you. It appears that my wife's unlawful termination at Infinity Property & Casualty is tied to our discovery efforts in that lawsuit. My wife and I first started hearing from debt collectors in the spring of 2007. Is it coincidence that both of us, since that time, have lost our jobs--me at the University of Alabama at Birmingham (UAB) and her at Infinity Property & Casualty?

Accounts with cease communications notification must be restricted from dialing. Pay special attention to negative items, which will include any accounts currently in collections. At least that will help the consumer to see if a debt collection company is using deceptive and/or illegal tactics. Each time one violated the law I filed a complaint with the FTC, in some case 15 or more complaints against the same collection company. Despite all of their illegal debt collection tactics such as calling my neighbors, leaving voice mail stating that they had papers with the Bulloch County District Attorney's Office, calling me at work dozens of times, committing perjury and fraud in court, even calling my company provided cell phone, I managed to stick it back to them all for violations of the Fair Debt Collection Practices Act (FDCPA) and outright fraud. They cannot call your friends, your neighbors, or the people you work with and reveal your financial situation. Though you are capable of paying financial obligations, it is good to learn about how you can properly handle the specific situation when debt collectors call.

Even a spouse's obligation to pay may be limited under state probate law. If a consumer believes FDCPA or state laws are being violated, they should file a complaint with the Justice Department of the State Attorney General's Office. If you also believe that your debt collector violated the terms of FDCPA then you also have the right to file a lawsuit. If your financial situation leads you to file for bankruptcy, the law assumes you're trying to pay your debts. Some individuals pay debts they do not owe just to get debt buyers to stop calling, or to ensure that the debt does not wrongfully end up on their credit report. Wouldn't you like to use the money you win from your creditors to pay off your debts? Part of the episode focused on the debt collectors they use, which often are virtually unregulated and use tactics such as harassment, threats and name-calling. When they do so legally (or pseudo-legally), they use subterfuges like making silent phone calls then using the "yes" that people normally use to greet others in phone calls as an actual acceptance of consent to pay the debt, convincing people to pay just a part of the debt by telling them they forgive the rest then suing to collect it, or (actually legally) suing and expecting people not to contest (which they normally don't).

While you may have a hard time dealing with payday lenders and debt collectors, you shouldn't have such a hard time when you deal with LoanMart. Debt collection refers to the methods lenders and the agents they hire resort to when consumers do not fulfill debt repayment agreements. Debt collectors have been known to post messages on social media sites to broadcast a consumer's indebtedness. There are several things that debt collectors are not allowed to do when attempting to collect the debt and there are things that they're not allowed to say. When debt collectors renew their license with the Bureau of Consumer Credit Protection, the amount of the bond depends on the company's gross monthly Maine collections for the previous year. If a law firm attempts to collect debts as a regular part of its practice, the firm is a "debt collector" under the FDCPA. A repossession agency, for example, may take automobiles off the street and have no regular practice of communicating with debtors in a way that a reasonable consumer would interpret as prompting the payment of money-indeed, such businesses may not communicate with debtors at all.<sup>75</sup> Such businesses are brought into the "debt collector" definition for the narrow prohibitive purposes of § 1692f(6) only. On the other hand, a business may enforce security interests as its principal purpose but not regularly collect debts; such a business does not satisfy the general definition and is a "debt collector" for purposes of section 1692f(6) only. And that a notice is required in order to advance a state foreclosure proceeding does not mean it cannot at the same time be an attempt to collect a debt and thus subject to the FDCPA.

The Fair Debt Collection Practices Act is the federal law that dictates how and when a debt collector may contact you. There are two primary types of personal bankruptcy: Chapter 13 and Chapter 7. Each must be filed in federal bankruptcy court. There are many fraudulent loan brokers and other individuals misrepresenting the availability of credit and credit terms. That issue has been examined a number of times in the past few years. Or your debt may be years old-sold, resold and resold some more. Time limits differ from state to state, and for different types of debt, but it's between three and six years in most states. Generally, there are no limits on the time a company can attempt to collect on a debt. Is there a time limit for collecting debt? That's some serious time! Confirm this time period before you take further action in paying off debt in collections. One tactic that has become especially effective - and is generally illegal - is the threat of jail time. Before obtaining a

court judgment, a bill collector generally has only one way of getting paid: Demand payment by calling you and sending you threatening letters. If collectors are able to prove that you owe money on a valid debt, then the court may issue judgment order.

#### Questions For/About Debt Collector Harassment Wrong Person

In most cases, you are not legally bound to pay these debts, but it really depends on how old the debt is and where you live. According to Section 807(11) of the FDCPA, the initial communication between a collector and a consumer must disclose that it's from a debt collector attempting to collect a debt and that any information obtained will be used for that purpose. In many countries there is legislation to limit harassment and practices deemed unfair, for example limiting the hours during which the agency may telephone the debtor, prohibiting communication of the debt to a third party, prohibiting false, deceptive or misleading representations, and prohibiting threats, as distinct from notice of planned and not illegal steps. If you choose debt settlement as your path to debt relief, you may shave a considerable amount off your principal balance owed. Also, the Act applies only to "debt collectors" and not to "creditors".

4. The Commissioner may make such rules and regulations as may be necessary to carry out the purposes of this section. Any other regulations as may be necessary to carry out the provisions of this section. 3. All requirements of this chapter with respect to original certificates, licenses and bonds apply with like force to all renewal certificates, licenses and bonds except as otherwise specified in this section. Otherwise they have to get permission from the original creditor. There is a chance, however, that any messages you have received may have been initiated before the creditor was aware of the filing. But there are ways to defend yourself against these bullies. We are not saying that any offer must be accepted but we have seen cases where offers are disregarded and a debtor is told that 'we are sending field agents'. But when the debtor is dead, the debt collectors almost always ignore this rule and, to the best of my knowledge, there's no case law on this yet.

Googling the attorney should give you a good idea of what he/she does. If he/she finds that the signatures were made by two different people, ask the handwriting expert to put those findings in writing. Along with his own letter, he'll need to send a copy of the handwriting expert's findings. Explain what's going on to the attorney and ask to hire him/her to notify the collection agency and original creditor of the handwriting expert's findings and demand that they cease collection efforts immediately and remove all negative information connected to the fraudulent personal guarantee from your credit report. If they continue to charge interest (based on the card agreement), you're going to want to see that contract. A collection agency is going to take great care not to openly harass you via mail.
