In the past, sometimes debt collectors would call alleged debtors and pretend to be taking a survey, in order to get more information to use against them. If a debtor takes this action, debt collectors cannot contact the debtor except to inform him of a lawsuit or other action taken against him to collect the debt. The Fair Debt Collection Practices Act very clearly defines the term debt collector as "any person who uses any instrumentality of interstate commerce or the mails in any business the principal purpose of which is the collection of any debts, or who regularly collects or attempts to collect, directly or indirectly, debts owed or due or asserted to be owed or due another." However, there are a number of unique exceptions to this definition also given in the act itself. Traditionally, we think of a "third party" entity as being someone other than an employee of the creditor (the person owed the money). In August 2005, Congress amended the Act to include a clause for Attorney's to try and argue out of being held strictly liable. The Fair Debt Credit Practices Act (FDCPA) is a strict liability Congressional Act created to help keep third party debt collectors from engaging in debt collection practices that are abusive, misleading, false, deceptive or violate your right to privacy.

The Fair Debt Collection Practices Act (FDCPA) protects consumers from unfair and abusive collection practices. Interlocutory debt collection process services can also be performed by a debt collection solicitor or legal attorney, who will act on behalf of the debt recovery agency, which has been hired by the original creditor. Debt collectors cannot lie to you, threaten you, or harass you. They call you nonstop, they're always trying to get money out of you, and you're constantly reminded of the debt you have hanging over your head. A debt collector can only garnish your wages or take money from your bank account without your consent if they sue you, win, and obtain a court order to do so. But if a creditor has a judgment against you, then it would be possible for them to garnish your bank account and take your stimulus money.

Though they are not allowed to threaten lawsuit or wage garnishment, if you do not pay a valid debt owed to them, Portfolio Recovery Associates may legally sue you in a court. If a bill collector debits your bank account without your permission and without a garnishment order, you have the right to sue. Debt collectors cannot call you at a time or place that they know is inconvenient for you, and never before 8 a.m. The FDCPA safeguards consumers from all the malpractices of the debt collectors and collection agencies. Earlier this year, the CFPB and the Federal Trade Commission issued a report analyzing nearly 75,200 consumer complaints about debt collection in 2019. It found that the most common complaint was about attempts to collect a debt that is not owed, followed by complaints about the failure of debt collectors to provide proper notice documenting the debt or informing the consumer of their rights. Of course, many fake debt collectors aren't randomly dialing victims.
