Debt collectors have one purpose-to get your money. Waive the debt, if you're on a low income, have no major assets, and your situation is unlikely to change. If you are concerned about the identity of the debt collector or its authority to collect the debt, contact the original creditor (if that person or company is different from the debt collector) to confirm the information. Give false credit information about you to anyone, including a credit reporting company. In most cases, the company can't take legal action against you while your matter is being dealt with by the Ombudsman Scheme. A Washington consumer reported receiving a similar "Wage Assignment Demand Notice" at their work. Publicizing a list of debtors (which you are a part of) is an FDCPA violation (except to a consumer reporting agency). Also, the collection officers are required to state that any information that has been obtained during communication can be used against the debtor or consumer. Debt collectors are not allowed to tell anyone else about the debt you owe unless you have given prior consent, except to: your attorney, creditor, creditor's attorney, a credit reporting agency, your spouse, or your parents (if you are a minor). When you owe debt to a collection agency, it is important to know what kinds of practices they can and cannot do. The business may send your outstanding balance to a debt collection company. Impersonating as such a member is against the law, unless the collection agency and the credit bureau are the same company. You also have the legal right to demand proof that you owe the debt; if the collection agency cannot prove you owe the original credit card debt they must cease all collection efforts.

If a debt collector is trying to track down someone you may know, they may call you one time-any more than this is considered harassment and is illegal-but may not reveal that the person owes a debt. Bankruptcy will stay on your credit file for six years, affecting your ability to access credit like mortgages (although, if you're already struggling to make debt payments, it is likely that you will have poor credit, anyway). Debt collectors cannot legally claim federal benefits, such as Social Security or your retirement accounts, like your IRA or 401(k) unless the debt is owed to the federal government. You do not have to reopen the case to add the debt. The debt collectors threatened to report consumers to law enforcement officials, disclosed consumers' debt information to employers and other third parties, and threatened to add more fees to the consumers' debts. Otherwise, you may not be able to include the debt. Debt collectors can receive commissions based on their collections, so they tend to be overly aggressive and may cross the line from a legal standpoint. Examples of common complaints against Viking Client Services include trying to collect a debt not owed and threatening to contact someone or share information improperly (eg: contacting your employer). As Tayne suggests, if you are contacted, you're under no obligation to immediately share your information. If so, here is some information that may help when talking to the debt collector.

Debt collectors cannot harass them, threaten them or otherwise act unfairly toward them to collect the debt, and debtors have the right to secure representation from an attorney regarding the debt. When debt collectors fail to abide by the law, debtors have legal remedies available. After the collectors receive this letter, they may only contact you once more to indicate they received your letter, or that they intend to pursue legal remedies. If we still haven't received any response or repayment within the given time we can send a final notice letter, which advises the debtor that ignoring the matter could result in a court judgment. A Complaint is a document that the debt collector files with the court that lays out how much money they think you owe them and details why they should be entitled to a judgment against you. During a phone call, a debt collector must identify him/herself and may not threaten violence against you or your family or use profane language. If you've missed a repayment on your credit card or home loan due to circumstances out of your control, the last thing you want is to have ongoing phone calls from a debt collector demanding money you don't have. Although debt collectors are simply doing their job, they often use unscrupulous methods to obtain money from debtors. The only exceptions are when state law allows additional charges or additional fees are outlined in the contract that created the debt. Your debt collector can't discuss the details of your debt with anyone other than yourself, your spouse or your attorney. "Millennials should seek the advice of an attorney who specializes in debt relief as well as FDCPA violations," Semrad says. Deceptive Representations. Debt collectors may not engage in deception in attempting to collect a debt. You may find that your debt with the agency is erased and they owe you funds when the law is violated. During these third party contacts, debt collectors and creditors may not reveal that you owe any debt.

If a bailiff comes into your home they'll usually make a list of anything of value you have that could be sold to pay off the debts. All you have to do is tell them that it is inconvenient for you to take their calls during work hours and that you could lose your job if they keep calling. No matter how much debt a person has anyone can stop calls made to their home, workplace, or cell phone by informing the collections agencies they do not wish to be contacted any longer. If a collection agency is harassing or otherwise mistreating you, contact the office of your state attorney general and the Federal Trade Commission to report the agency. Just as creditors have the right to collect, you have the right to question the validity of a debt and file formal complaints of unfair or deceptive collection attempts with the Federal Trade Commission or your state attorney general. But, I also believe that they may not be aware of the potential reactions that may be created when sending a debt validation letter on a valid debt.
