Get the debt taken off your credit file. Collectors get commissions -- usually 30 to 50% -- on money they bring in, which often double or triple their salaries. Most third-party collection agencies work on a fee or percentage arrangement with clients who are owed the money. Even if they are successful in court, there is still no guarantee the person will pay them.

As for how long an unpaid credit card bill might stay on your credit report, the number to keep in mind is seven years. Failing to cease communication upon request; communicating with consumers in any way (other than litigation) after receiving written notice that the consumer wishes no further communication or refuses to pay the alleged debt. If a consumer sends a written dispute or request for verification to a debt collector within 30-days of receiving a Section 1692g notice, then the debt collector must either (a) mail the consumer the requested information or (b) cease collection efforts altogether. This includes certain exceptions such as advising collection efforts are being terminated or that the collector intends to file a lawsuit or pursue other remedies where permitted. Chapter 41, Subchapter I, Sections 1601 through 1667f, deal with consumer credit cost disclosures; Subchapter II, Sections 1671 through 1677, address restrictions on the garnishment process; Subchapter II-A, Sections 1679 through 1679j, announce rules and regulations regarding credit repair organizations; Subchapter IV, Sections 1691 through 1691f, quantify equal credit opportunities; Subchapter V, Sections 1692 through 1692p, regulate debt collection practices; and Subchapter VI, Sections 1693 through 1693r, set parameters for electronic fund transfers. Among the debt-collection firms that Accretive has acquired is a California-based outfit called Eskanos & Adler.

One thing you need to know, however, is that regardless of the amount you owe, the law protects you from being harassed through invasive and repeated phone calls from debt collectors. The Fair Debt Collection Practices Act (FDCPA) is designed to provide the protection consumers need. Do you need the item off your credit reports and want to try and settle the rating as well? Keep records of every single telephone call or correspondence sent by the debt collector to you with the date, time, and individual you spoke with.

For example if you told them to stop calling you and they refuse then you need to follow up with a letter to the collection agency certified mail- return receipt requested putting your demand in writing. You need hard work and negotiation skills to navigate. For example, a college student client was threatened that she be arrested if she did not pay a credit card debt, and another client was called 12 times in one day at work about a debt that was 14 years old. Calling multiple times a day about a debt or contacting you at unusual times is considered harassment. Who qualifies as a debt collector under Maine law?

If the Commissioner denies the application, he may in his order forbid the applicant from participating in the business of the collection agency. Use any business name which is identical or similar to a business name used by another collection agency licensed under this chapter or which may mislead or confuse the public. The written consent must contain an agreement with the customer as to all terms and conditions of the assignment or transfer, including the name and address of the intended assignee. Prior written consent of the Commissioner must also be obtained for any bulk assignment or transfer of claims or accounts, and any assignment or transfer may be regulated and made subject to such limitations or conditions as the Commissioner by regulation may reasonably prescribe. 3. Assign or transfer any claim or account upon termination or abandonment of its collection business unless prior written consent by the customer is given for the assignment or transfer. 2. The filing of any report required by this section which is known by the collection agency to contain false information or statements constitutes grounds for the suspension of the agency's license or the manager's certificate, or both.
