At the federal level, the Fair Debt Collection Practices Act (FDCPA) limits what debt collection companies can do when collecting certain types of debt. Consumers DO have rights to fight back against unscrupulous collectors, but you must be able to provide proof that you've done your due diligence before such rights can be (reliably) upheld (see section 813 "Civil liability" in the FDCPA Act). Before it was up to the consumer to know this as a defense when dealing with collectors, and many collectors would be hoping to trick the consumer into paying the expired debt, but now there is a greater move to inform consumers of their rights. While there are plenty of tactics that debt collectors can legally employ to try to collect the money you owe, they must comply with the restrictions imposed by the FDCPA or they may face legal consequences.

Yes. A debt collector in Illinois must be licensed with the Illinois Department of Financial and Professional Regulation before doing collections actions like filing a lawsuit. If you succeed in doing these steps, some circumstances still allow debt collectors to contact you. Collectors may not show up at your home or place of work and cannot claim to be attorneys or credit reporting agencies.
