This is both a grotesque violation of the FDCPA--which prohibits any false or deceiving statements to alleged debtors--and it also represents fraud under Alabama state law. "In some states, a voluntary payment on a stale debt can revive the debt and make it legally collectible," Ginsberg warns. In most states, the statute of limitations runs four to six years from the date you last made a payment.

Most creditors and debt collection companies will want to give you the time to deal with your debt problems, and it's certainly better for them if you organise your debts enough to pay at least some of them off, rather than them having to spend time and money chasing you for debts. Communication is limited to 3 times per week or one time per week at the person's place of employment. Communication with a third party is limited to one contact. The act also regulates the communication that debt collectors can have with your family members. Not only is it important to know your rights, but you have access to services to manage the debt so these collections calls will stop. If the debt has already been turned over, the collection agencies have dozens of people who do nothing but make phone calls all day. Even if you know that you owe money, you want to make sure that this creditor proves it to you. Let your collectors know why you are unable to pay at this time (hospitalization, loss of a job, other major expenses etc.) and let them know when you estimate that you will be able to pay for something.

The FDCPA allows consumers to sue debt collectors for deceptive or abusive conduct. However, under the Fair Debt Collection Practices Act, debt collectors cannot call you before 8:00 a.m. When a debt collector calls, it's possible that you've already taken care of the debt and no longer owe the money. If you've been targeted for this sort of abuse, you can make it stop. If they call you at work or at all hours, or if a debt collector is abusive or dishonest with you, you can take legal steps to stop the abuse, and the right debt collection attorney will help you.
